- Mark out the sites of detonations, define and supervise the work process in order to avoid accidents;
- Delegate tasks to persons under his/her supervision, operate the drill when drilling blast holes;
- Supervise the detonation site, comply with safety regulations;
- Place detonators and explosives in blast holes or in exposed positions, attach fuses or electric wires;
- Tamp the loaded explosives, trigger the detonation, assess the results of the detonation;
- Provide first aid, take the necessary security and preventive measures in case of extraordinary events.
