- Operate pneumatic, hydraulic machines, replace faulty components and equipment;
- Hand over, take receipt of, inspect work areas;
- Assemble product transportation equipment, install bore-hole, transport, move material, install and remove self-propelled support equipment, construct temporary railway and extend conveyor equipment;
- Operate the breaking and screening equipment, deposit the product, locate the waste, set up the dump area, safe slopes;
- Construct surface facilities, set up the energy supply;
- Clean and adjust the equipment, perform small and medium-sized repair operations;
- Operate internal combustion and electric machines;
- After work has been completed record any significant information relating to the machine or the working environment, document any extraordinary events in connection with operation in the operation log;
- Perform work sitting, standing, whilst moving, occasionally with climbing, balancing, bending and in other forced positions, including lifting; Expose the arms, hands, fingers, the body and limbs to difficult physical exertion whilst performing the task;
- Perform work in noisy workplaces exposed to the weather, that are wet, damp, dusty, smoky, contaminated with gases, withstand the vibration involved;
- Deal with dangerous situations, prevent accidents, give first aid, assist with emergency work.
