- Evaluate the most typical general and specific features, similarities and differences between handwritings on the basis of the aspects of examination;
- Determine or reveal the personal, technical circumstances of creating the piece of handwriting;
- Reveal and explain the cause of differences, similarities, contradictions;
- Perform the analysis of the graphic productions of personalities of different ages, the survey of their special physical and psychical status;
- Select the psychological model needed for the examination, the personality signs suiting the aspect of examination specially related to the examined areas;
- Use a control method and consult with other specialists, if necessary;
- Answer, give advice and refer clients to specialists on the basis on the basis of questions arising in connection with the result of the examinations;
- Apply legal acts relating to data protection and personality rights.
