- use protective equipment for accident prevention, comply with and apply environmental protection requirements;
- arrange the transportation of used materials and waste, keep contact with local public utilities;
- assess the work to be carried out, prepare a quotation on the repair work to be carried out incl. the expected time required for completion;
- document measurement results using a computer, prepare and use technical documentation;
- carry out maintenance, diagnostic and repair work on vehicle equipment and safety systems;
- verify the vehicle's condition, measure elements using devices, then carry out an operational test;
- operate car washing equipment, clean and treat the vehicle inside and outside;
- prepare invoices, advertise or recommend own services, keep contact with customers;
- perform the simple starting, operational, administrative and market-related tasks of a sole proprietorship;
- submit the vehicle for examination, measure vehicle performance;
- verify special structures, e.g. fire truck, ladder truck, truck crane, mixer or refrigerated vehicle;
- assess the working time utilisation of workers and operational capacity, analyse financial efficiency;
- interpret and use complex technical plans;
- operate units using codes in vehicles, set up and activate such units;
- follow changes in professional and economical requirements and apply them, monitor professional literature, participate in further training courses.
