- participate in relocating the crane and placing it into active service;
- perform movement within the storage unit, prepare the fuel cartridge required for relocation, move nuclear fuel with the crane, place used fuel in the tubes of the Temporary Storage for Used Fuel Cassettes (KKÁT);
- participate in verifying the intactness of and cleaning nuclear fuel;
- ensure the operability of systems and equipment required for removing used fuel, notify and coordinate participants in the removal of used fuel;
- prepare and ensure the conditions required for maintenance, participate in verification and testing of equipment undergoing maintenance following repairs;
- recognise and identify malfunctions, carry out on-site activities required for repairing malfunctions independently or under the direction of the operative superior;
- keep updated records of fresh and used, stored fuels;
- verify the order of the plant, fire protection and safety equipment;
- disclose data as required, assist the work of international oversight organisations.
