- disinfect using physical, chemical and gas procedures;
- perform disinfection on diverse surfaces and disinfect diverse materials;
- apply special disinfection methods in patient care;
- perform prevention-purpose and continuous disinfection;
- perform lice screening tests;
- operate disinfection machines and equipment;
- perform sterilisation using autoclaves, hot air sterilisers, ethylene oxid and formaldehyde gases and hydrogen peroxide plasma;
- use reagents and bioindicators;
- operate sterilisers and check their operation;
- observe work safety, accident protection and environmental protection regulations during work performance.
