- Take anamnesis;
- Knowing the actual diseases of the ear, assess the possibilities of carrying out audiometry tests;
- Based on the results of the threshold tests, plan further examinations;
- Perform Weber and Rinne tests, pure-tone threshold tests, speech audiometry tests, above-threshold tests, record the results and interpret the findings thereof;
- Perform tinnitometry, and record the results and interpret the findings thereof;
- Perform audiometry tests;
- As necessary, perform masking, and record the results and interpret the findings thereof;
- Perform tympanometry, and record the results and interpret the findings thereof;
- Perform stapedius reflex tests, otoacoustic emission tests, BERA tests, and record the results and interpret the findings thereof;
- When performing audiometry tests and on the assessment of the validity of measurements, apply medical notations related to the Eustachian tube;
- Visually inspect the outer ear, the acoustic meatus and the eardrum, and recognise any abnormality;
- Record the status of the ear and the results of audiometry tests;
- Assess the needs and demands of the patient, and assess the factors impacting the choice and installation of hearing aids;
- Provide information about the possibilities of aural rehabilitation;
- Order hearing aids;
- Install hearing aids and hearing instruments;
- Perform the fine tuning of hearing instruments;
- Provide information about other accessory equipment;
- Teach the insertion of the hearing aid and the use of the hearing instrument;
- Determine the fault of the hearing aid;
- Assess diverse possibilities of repair;
- Perform smaller-scale jobs of repairing hearing aids;
- Manage customer complaints.
