3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

- carry out basic nursing tasks related to patients under his/her supervision in the scope of his/her activity;
- help in meeting the physiological and higher level needs of ill/healthy individuals of different ages;
- provide help according to the condition and request of the patient in moving, relaxation, nourishing, hygiene as well as in maintenance of excretory functions and appropriate body temperature, and in the provision of oxygen;
- prepare the necessary instruments for different instrumental and laboratory examinations as well as for therapeutic and diagnostic interventions;
- assist in the execution of laboratory and instrumental examinations
- assist the nurse/physician in the execution of diagnostic and therapeutic interventions;
- organise his/her work according to the basic principles of the nursing process;
- maintain a secure environment for nursing, handle infectious materials and instruments according to regulations;
- store instruments, textiles, and bandages of nursing;
- carry out tasks related to medication with respect to oral, transdermal, and transmucosal medication as well as administer sub-cutaneous insulin injection with the guidance of a nurse and on the basis of a physician's written order;
- observe and evaluate symptoms of the patient, note deviation from physiological state;
- apply physiological, patho-physiological and clinical knowledge during his/her work;
- participate in nursing patients of different ages as a ;
- communicate with patients and their relatives, and nursing team members;
- complete nursing documentation related to this/her work;
- fulfil necessary duties related to the deceased;
- provide first aid for accident victims if needed;
- apply medical terminology orally and in writing;
- apply information and communication technology instruments;
- execute his/her work according to the basic principles of the psychology and ethics of nursing;
- continually improve his/her knowledge;
- comply with work safety, fire and accident protection regulations during his/her work.

The basis of the grading system is a list of vocational and examination requirements compiled in accordance with uniform criteria and structure, issued in the form of legal regulation that includes the following:

- identification number and description of the vocational qualification as specified in OKJ and the relevant FEOR number,
- school and vocational prequalification required for the start of the training, aptitude and vocational competence requirements and prescribed practice,
- the most typical occupation or activity accessible to the holder of the vocational qualification certificate, the short job description, and the list of related vocational qualifications,
- the duration of the training required for the vocational qualification; maximum number of hours; the ratio of theoretical and practical training; the number of vocational training classes in the vocational training school; the duration of initial training period; the possibility of organising a grade examination assessing the efficiency of practical training,
- occupational requirements of vocational qualification

- requirements pertaining to vocational examination.

The vocational and examination requirements will be classified by the occupational group committees of the National Qualification Register (OKJ) and by the National Council for Vocational Training, and subsequently they will be issued in the form of legal regulations.
