3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES**A typical holder of the certificate is able to:**

- ensure the prerequisites of performing work and follow special regulations according to the customary machines, devices and technological processes of the trade;
- make out draft and professional technical drawing complying with the effectual plotting regulations and make out samples;
- make out and store dollop expertly, prepare clay for wheeling, make out plate, roundel, mould, mix and filter glaze, coatings, moulding dollop, prepare under-coating and above-coating paints;
- apply the nexuses of material-construction-shape-function during making out unique or small-series pottery items and set of items with individual work and craftsman technology
- make out consumer goods (pots, ornament items) - wheeled from clay, burnt uncoated red (terracotta) and uncoated black (reduction burned), coated (mostly lead- and tin-coated)-, from non-fireproof, fireproof or flameproof material, using the traditional shapes and styling elements of pottery ;
- plan and make out sets, sets of items, based on traditions but also taking into consideration the present days' needs;
- program a furnace, put into, burn, cool and take out products with the knowledge of burning processes, as well as burn with traditional naked light furnace;
- prepare, decorate and coat a semi-finished product, burn coated product with the expert operation of the furnace and with the knowledge of coatings;
- make simple gypsum imprints and make out simple gypsum moulds;
- verify the quality of raw- and supplementary materials and finished products, as well as devices, machines, tools and instruments in terms of accident prevention.

The basis of the grading system is a list of vocational and examination requirements compiled in accordance with uniform criteria and structure, issued in the form of legal regulation that includes the following:

- identification number and description of the vocational qualification as specified in OKJ and the relevant FEOR number,
- school and vocational prequalification required for the start of the training, aptitude and vocational competence requirements and prescribed practice,
- the most typical occupation or activity accessible to the holder of the vocational qualification certificate, the short job description, and the list of related vocational qualifications,
- the duration of the training required for the vocational qualification; maximum number of hours; the ratio of theoretical and practical training; the number of vocational training classes in the vocational training school; the duration of initial training period; the possibility of organising a grade examination assessing the efficiency of practical training,
- occupational requirements of vocational qualification,
- requirements pertaining to vocational examination.

The vocational and examination requirements will be classified by the occupational group committees of the National Qualification Register (OKJ) and by the National Council for Vocational Training, and subsequently they will be issued in the form of legal regulations.
