- A typical holder of the certificate is able to:
- handle the measuring tools required for determining the quantity of work, conduct site surveys;
- conduct site tests of surfaces, finishes, use a moisture tester;
- provide for the proper protection of any adjoining finishes, structures, and fixtures;
- properly install and handle any ladders, stands, etc., move rolling scaffolds;
- install, operate, clean, and maintain any small machines not subject to operator's qualification;
- mark and measure on the surfaces any details indicated on the plan;
- properly handle mechanical cleaning tools and small machines;
- properly use the materials ensuring the appropriate bond of undercoats and final coats;
- eliminate the defects of metal, wood and masonry surfaces (filling, knotting, stopping);
- prepare the material, cover, and decoration of white and coloured lime wash, use any tools required;
- prepare sizes, mix the material of and properly use distemper, select and handle the necessary tools and machines;
- apply both interior and exterior emulsion paints and paints made with silicate binders, modify and fine-tune shades;
- produce finishes of appropriate quality from paints using diluents;
- apply the most common decorating techniques, select and use the appropriate tools and equipment (rolling, dragging, surface treatments: sponging, ragging, stencilling, plastic dragging, antiquing, colour and course sprinkling);
- apply different exterior and interior preservatives, prepare and renovate the transparent and coloured finishes of timber surfaces, apply varnish and renovate parquet floors and other hardwood surfaces;
- strip old wallpapers, recognize and properly apply different types of wallpapers;
- properly hang the most common types of semi-heavy and heavy wallpapers, select, use, and maintain the tools and equipment required;
- properly use and renovate rolled wall coverings (Rauhfaser, glass fibre, fibrous wallpapers);
- apply finishes with (synthetic) resin and oil binders to both exterior and interior metal structures (painting), using both hand and power tools;
- apply finishes to metal equipment and building fixtures exposed to high temperatures;
- prepare decorative, plastic mouldings with factory-made finished products;
- put in place, install, and cover special expanded foam and gypsum elements, decorative accessories;
- prepare glued insulation systems and apply covering materials to them;
- mix the right shade of paint to match the sample colour or material provided;
- identify materials, conduct on-site quality testing;
- establish and control safe working conditions;
- commission, properly use, and maintain any personal protecting equipment required.

The basis of the grading system is a list of vocational and examination requirements compiled in accordance with uniform criteria and structure, issued in the form of legal regulation that includes the following:

- identification number and description of the vocational qualification as specified in OKJ and the relevant FEOR number,
- school and vocational prequalification required for the start of the training, aptitude and vocational competence requirements and prescribed practice,
- the most typical occupation or activity accessible to the holder of the vocational qualification certificate, the short job description, and the list of related vocational qualifications,
- the duration of the training required for the vocational qualification; maximum number of hours; the ratio of theoretical and practical training; the number of vocational training classes in the vocational training school; the duration of initial training period; the possibility of organising a grade examination assessing the efficiency of practical training,
- occupational requirements of vocational qualification,
- requirements pertaining to vocational examination.

The vocational and examination requirements will be classified by the occupational group committees of the National Qualification Register (OKJ) and by the National Council for Vocational Training, and subsequently they will be issued in the form of legal regulations.
