A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

- relying on his/her specialised theoretical and practical preparedness, perform the following jobs in addition to tasks related to general installation, failure detection, testing, selection of materials, labour safety and environmental protection; take part in:
- = the preparation and implementation of tempering processes of semi-finished and finished products made of non-ferrous and light metal alloys, unalloyed, alloyed and special structural and tool steels as well as of cast irons relying on professional instructions, = the commissioning as well as professional and economic running of tempering furnaces, furnace systems,
- = the detection of the root cause of breakdowns under supervision
- the repair and elimination of minor instances of faulty operation,
- = the selection, adjustment, professional use and maintenance of mechanical as well as other auxiliary equipment and hand tools necessary for tempering,
- = the selection, preparation and application of indirect materials necessary for tempering bearing environmental aspects in mind;
- participate in the quality assurance of tempering processes and products;
- perform simple quality assurance tests on materials necessary for technological processes as well as on tempered products;
- interpret and apply technical documentation necessary for producing pieces as well as for the execution of assembly and tempering jobs;
- observe labour safety and environmental protection related regulations while at work and during commissioning.

Further information (including the description of the national grading method):

The basis of the grading system is a list of vocational and examination requirements compiled in accordance with uniform criteria and structure, issued in the form of legal regulation that includes the following:

- identification number and description of the vocational qualification as specified in OKJ and the relevant FEOR number,
- school and vocational prequalification required for the start of the training, aptitude and vocational competence requirements and prescribed practice,
- the most typical occupation or activity accessible to the holder of the vocational qualification certificate, the short job description, and the list of related vocational qualifications,
- the duration of the training required for the vocational qualification; maximum number of hours; the ratio of theoretical and practical training; the number of vocational training classes in the vocational training school; the duration of initial training period; the possibility of organising a grade examination assessing the efficiency of practical training,
- occupational requirements of vocational qualification,
- requirements pertaining to vocational examination.

The vocational and examination requirements will be classified by the occupational group committees of the National Qualification Register (OKJ) and by the National Council for Vocational Training, and subsequently they will be issued in the form of legal regulations.
