- A typical holder of the certificate is able to: - carry out ornamental-plant cultivation activities: = propagation, cultivation and care of various ornamental-plants (annual, biennial, perennial ornamental-plants, deciduous and evergreen ornamental trees, ornamental shrubberies, greenhouse potted leaf-plants and flowering ornamental plants, cut flowers and cut greens, forced ornamental-plants). - carry out activities for landscape gardening and park maintenance: = execution of fundamental works of landscape gardening; landscaping, levelling of the ground, spreading of arable soil, = preparation and maintenance of superstructures and garden technical establishments: road and space surfaces, stairs, garden counterforts, fences, embankments, pergolas and flower-lattices, basins, playgrounds and sports grounds, roof-gardens, rock-gardens, = bedding out ornamental-plants in parks, balcony cases, stone pots, on graves, = carrying out fundamental duties of park care: re-plantation, pruning, cleaning, replacement of plants, tree protection, felling of trees, weeding, watering, plant protection, = establishment and maintenance of lawn: lawn-mowing, grass trimming, pick-up of sod of grass. - carry out flower arrangement activities: = treatment and preparation for flower arrangement works, of plants and plant parts distributed in flower arrangement and flower trade, = preparation and packing of bunches, quilted compositions (vase ornaments, flower dishes, flower baskets), collective plantings, wreathes, other ornaments suitable for various events, by the use of living and dried flowers, plants, artificial flowers, accessories and industrial auxiliary materials, = execution of flower arrangement works related to holidays (Eastern, Advent, Christmas, national holidays) and to outstanding occasions (wedding, burial, All Souls' Day). - carry out any business and entrepreneurial activities: = performance of sales force duties in flower sales outlets of various levels (stand, pavilion, shop, saloon), in specialized stores for the wholesale of flower accessories, depots for tree nurseries, in works for ornamental-plant growing, = provision of basic administrative and book-keeping tasks, = carrying out independent entrepreneurial activities, - carry out management and organization activities: = organization and management of the activities of task forces, = use of the various communication and information technology equipment. - use, operate and maintain the machines, tools, equipment and material required to the execution of the activity, in a professional manner.

The basis of the grading system is a list of vocational and examination requirements compiled in accordance with uniform criteria and structure, issued in the form of legal regulation that includes the following:

- identification number and description of the vocational qualification as specified in OKJ and the relevant FEOR number,

- school and vocational prequalification required for the start of the training, aptitude and vocational competence requirements and prescribed practice,
- the most typical occupation or activity accessible to the holder of the vocational qualification certificate, the short job description, and the list of related vocational qualifications,
- the duration of the training required for the vocational qualification; maximum number of hours; the ratio of theoretical and practical training; the number of vocational training classes in the vocational training school; the duration of initial training period; the possibility of organising a grade examination assessing the efficiency of practical training,
- occupational requirements of vocational qualification,
- requirements pertaining to vocational examination.

The vocational and examination requirements will be classified by the occupational group committees of the National Qualification Register (OKJ) and by the National Council for Vocational Training, and subsequently they will be issued in the form of legal regulations.
