- participate in prevention, health conservation, and health education, in recognition and treatment of occupational diseases or diseases related one's occupation, in recognition of aetiologic factors as well as in performing tasks of public health and epidemiology at workplaces including tasks of occupational health care, administration, and documentation, as a member of the occupational health care team at basic occupational health service providers, occupational health centres and occupational health units;
- in the framework of basic occupational health services, under the control of the service's physician, participate in:
  - = aptitude examinations provided for in a single regulation and in referring employees to specialists,
  - = reporting and examination of cases of occupational diseases and increased exposition as provided for in a single regulation,
  - = examination of health damaging effects of working activities,
  - = consultation regarding personal protection devices,
  - = consultation regarding working conditions of employees,
  - = identifying hazard sources at workplaces,
  - = fulfilling tasks related to occupational health, physiology, ergonomics, and hygiene,
  - = organisation of first aid and urgent medical care and professional training of persons providing first aid,
  - = drawing up employer's plans for prevention, eradication, and rehabilitation of catastrophes,
  - = occupational health rehabilitation activities,
  - = second degree evaluation of occupational aptitude,
  - = second degree evaluation of health aptitude for obtaining and keeping small arms, arms used as warning devices or alarms, and ammunitions,
  - = occupational aptitude examination of unemployed individuals before school admittance and in the framework of preparation for labour market,
  - = occupational aptitude examination of unemployed individuals for work in the public interest,
  - = providing special health care service for patients with occupational disease or the suspicion thereof,
  - = consulting activity for other specialists regarding occupational diseases,
  - = occupational hygiene consultation for the basic occupational health service,
  - = organisation of occupational health service at request of county health officer and in supervision of basic service providers directed by senior county/municipal physician specialized in occupational health,
  - = occupational aptitude examination of students of institutions providing vocational training or higher education as provided for in a single regulation,
  - = preparation of expert opinion for employment centres regarding employment possibilities of unemployed individuals with partial working capabilities,
- carry out in all the above three areas:
  - = administration and documentation,
  - = use of modern technical (information technology) devices.

The basis of the grading system is a list of vocational and examination requirements compiled in accordance with uniform criteria and structure, issued in the form of legal regulation that includes the following:

- identification number and description of the vocational qualification as specified in OKJ and the relevant FEOR number,
- school and vocational prequalification required for the start of the training, aptitude and vocational competence requirements and prescribed practice,
- the most typical occupation or activity accessible to the holder of the vocational qualification certificate, the short job description, and the list of related vocational qualifications,
- the duration of the training required for the vocational qualification; maximum number of hours; the ratio of theoretical and practical training; the number of vocational training classes in the vocational training school; the duration of initial training period; the possibility of organising a grade examination assessing the efficiency of practical training,
- occupational requirements of vocational qualification,
- requirements pertaining to vocational examination.

The vocational and examination requirements will be classified by the occupational group committees of the National Qualification Register (OKJ) and by the National Council for Vocational Training, and subsequently they will be issued in the form of legal regulations.
