- perform a geometrical survey of the surfaces to be restored, based on his/her knowledge of monument protection and the basic steps of restoration and professional documentation, and properly document the condition and decoration of the surfaces with drawings and photos;
- draw geometric and plane decoration motifs, plane figure decorations and folk decorations related to decoration painting tasks;
- properly use decoration painting tools, instruments and auxiliary materials;
- professionally analyse surfaces, recognise surface defects and find the cause of these defects, prepare and perform the preliminary finishing of surfaces based on his/her knowledge of restoration processes;
- perform decoration painting in new buildings and buildings to be renovated, or, as necessary, protected buildings applying his/her knowledge of art history, construction history and professional history;
- recognise silicate, wooden, metal and plastic surfaces and surfaces with old-type coating;
- select the appropriate material based on his/her knowledge of the types of paints, pigments, reinforcers and binders used for decoration painting, and the composition of lime and casein coating, gluey, synthetic resin, emulsion and oil and resin binding paints;
- draw and paint decoration paintings manually and with patterns;
- apply paints diluted with water and solvents on surfaces with various bases;
- coat and decorate stucco, make paintings for advertising purposes, make inscriptions, complete incomplete patterns, restore and apply the new methods of surface decorations.

The basis of the grading system is a list of vocational and examination requirements compiled in accordance with uniform criteria and structure, issued in the form of legal regulation that includes the following:

- identification number and description of the vocational qualification as specified in OKJ and the relevant FEOR number,
- school and vocational prequalification required for the start of the training, aptitude and vocational competence requirements and prescribed practice,
- the most typical occupation or activity accessible to the holder of the vocational qualification certificate, the short job description, and the list of related vocational qualifications,
- the duration of the training required for the vocational qualification; maximum number of hours; the ratio of theoretical and practical training; the number of vocational training classes in the vocational training school; the duration of initial training period; the possibility of organising a grade examination assessing the efficiency of practical training,
- occupational requirements of vocational qualification,
- requirements pertaining to vocational examination.

The vocational and examination requirements will be classified by the occupational group committees of the National Qualification Register (OKJ) and by the National Council for Vocational Training, and subsequently they will be issued in the form of legal regulations.
