A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

- Electronic and mechanic security system adjusters carry out the preparation and installation of electronic devices falling within the scope of security, and the basic programming of adjustable tools used within such systems. Based on the knowledge acquired during the vocational training, they are able to judge whether existing mechanical systems are efficient, and to give advice related to the installation of new systems.
- Due to his or her professional qualification, he or she is able to examine and measure mechanical and electronic security devices used during his or her work, and handle such measuring devices.
- he has basic knowledge related to mechanical security system devices, and is able to give advices with respect to their application, and perform smaller corrections on such systems (such as changing locks).
- installation, repair and maintenance of car alarm systems, central locks and window lifters
- installation, deployment, maintenance, repair of different elements of electonic security alarm systems, installation and setup of home alarm centers
- installation, setup, maintenance of outdoor and indoor closed circuit industrial TV systems, and repair certain elements
- independent planning and installation of simpler systems
- professional and safe handling of equipment, devices, tools and materials necessary for his or her work

The basis of the grading system is a list of vocational and examination requirements compiled in accordance with uniform criteria and structure, issued in the form of legal regulation that includes the following:

- identification number and description of the vocational qualification as specified in OKJ and the relevant FEOR number,
- school and vocational prequalification required for the start of the training, aptitude and vocational competence requirements and prescribed practice,
- the most typical occupation or activity accessible to the holder of the vocational qualification certificate, the short job description, and the list of related vocational qualifications,
- the duration of the training required for the vocational qualification; maximum number of hours; the ratio of theoretical and practical training; the number of vocational training classes in the vocational training school; the duration of initial training period; the possibility of organising a grade examination assessing the efficiency of practical training,
- occupational requirements of vocational qualification,
- requirements pertaining to vocational examination.

The vocational and examination requirements will be classified by the occupational group committees of the National Qualification Register (OKJ) and by the National Council for Vocational Training, and subsequently they will be issued in the form of legal regulations.
