- Group and describe the types of leather and other materials used in the belt and saddle maker profession, taking into account the basic terms related to the materials;
- Select the materials to be tailored;
- Define firmness, thickness and elongation;
- Select the supplies used in the profession in accordance with their function;
- Professionally perform the tailoring of cowhide and other leather materials;
- Select the machine appropriate for the cutting of materials;
- Apply tailoring machines in accordance with the requirements for labour protection;
- Apply decorating processes;
- Professionally prepare belts necessary for decorations with traditional and modern tools;
- Perform decorating processes of girth making, button knitting, weaving, frippery making;
- Perform manual sewing;
- Perform different types of sewing with sewing machines used in this profession;
- Set up machines in a professional way appropriate for the product in question;
- Apply and comply with rules of labour protection, environmental protection, fire protection, security technology;
- Apply knowledge related to labour law, economy and entrepreneurship.

- the most typical occupation or activity accessible to the holder of the vocational qualification certificate, the short job description, and the list of related vocational qualifications,
- the duration of the training required for the vocational qualification; maximum number of hours; the ratio of theoretical and practical training; the number of vocational training classes in the vocational training school; the duration of initial training period; the possibility of organising a grade examination assessing the efficiency of practical training,
- occupational requirements of vocational qualification,
- requirements pertaining to vocational examination.

The vocational and examination requirements will be classified by the occupational group committees of the National Qualification Register (OKJ) and by the National Council for Vocational Training, and subsequently they will be issued in the form of legal regulations.
