3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES**A typical holder of the certificate is able to:**

- perform nail care using classical, modern (French) or Japanese manicure technology, apply other decorations; do nicer and more resistant acrylic nails taking advantage of the characteristics of gel or porcelain by using patterns, tip-nail, nail strengthening, nail bed lengthening, decoration and filling technologies;
- advise clients on how to keep the effects of the treatment using at-home methods;
- wash and dry hair; change hair colour (bleach, dye, tint, highlight); do permanent waves, carry out volume increasing and hair straightening procedures; shave facial hair and trim, cut, tint and dye beard and moustache; advise clients on hair care and professional hairdressing products; sanitize the instruments used, prepare instruments, check their condition, maintain them and clean and sanitize them after use;
- pay special attention not to put in danger or harm the clients' health while providing the service and to work only on healthy hands; start by analyzing the clients' hair or hands and if any unhealthy alteration is found, decide how the service should be provided or suggest consulting a doctor;
- run their business in compliance with the regulations in force, profitably, and ensure and maintain safe working conditions.
