**3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES**

**A typical holder of the certificate is able to:**

- comply with the rules of military service, procedure and the military dress code, as part of NCOs' basic military tasks;
- handle and maintain personal firearms, protective tools and equipment;
- perform guard duty, tour of duty, stand-by duty, courier duty and provost duty;
- perform the tasks on the agenda, support their commander by cooperating in the management of the daily activity of the subordinate unit;
- perform technical, logistical, tactical and communicational tasks, self-help and mutual aid, disaster prevention and management and tasks related to military operations other than war;
- plan, organize and carry out the training of subordinates, develop themselves by self-education on military and professional issues, train their bodies;
- keep computer records, create electronic documents;
- handle, operate, test, maintain and repair smaller errors of combat support equipment pertaining to their position;
- comply with and enforce safety regulations prescribed for military exercises, perform occupational safety and health, fire and environmental protection tasks;
- learn and carry out tasks and norms of conduct deriving from NATO membership, communicate in military English at NATO STANAG 6001 1.1.1.1 level during their military and professional activity;
- build and develop the community of the subordinate unit, motivate subordinates, manage conflicts and stressful situations;
- ensure communication between members of the army and military organizations in the one hand and civilians and civil organizations on the other;
- plan and organize the training and progress of subordinates, facilitate their self-education and learning, prepare personalized physical fitness programmes for them;
- cooperate in the mentoring and family support programmes of the subordinate units;
- cooperate in the national defence education programme and the training of officers and NCOs.
