- operate machinery, complete lifting tasks with dedicated equipment;;
- move machines around the work site as needed;;
- select, use and inspect strapping devices, hoists and lifting equipment;;
- communicate with strappers and site foremen;;
- perform end-of-shift duties in accordance with relevant technical and safety instructions;;
- comply with relevant requirements governing work safety, accident and fire prevention and environmental protection;;
- comply with relevant technological rules and regulations concerning on and off-loading;;
- use personal and collective protective equipment designated for the machine and the job at hand;;
- recognise and report safety hazards and factors presenting a health risk;;
- proceed in line with the job description in the event of an accident or emergency.
