- To be familiar with and be able to apply the cutting-edge potentials of the media;
- To collect source materials and information, find inspirations to carry out a work and to develop concepts;
- Be informed about the current financial/legal conditions of employment and ventures;
- Apply the acquired marketing knowledge;
- Develop a clientele – perform market research, seek clients and customers;
- Prepare drafts and be able to present his/her concepts in the form of a drawing or a structure;
- Continuously use and expand his/her knowledge in art history, folk art and art philosophy;
- Take part in the manufacturing and implementing process, ensure that the product made complies with the original design.
