- perform tasks related to quality assurance and improve processes;
- continuously monitor and assess patient health status;
- provide mental support to the patient and relatives, perform health educating activities;
- perform patients' triage classification and registration using various checklists;
- manage patients in critical health condition;
- recognise acute life-threatening health conditions and eliminate such danger at the appropriate level;
- assess and satisfy the needs of patients requiring emergency care;
- prepare patients and the necessary equipment for diagnostic tests;
- perform diagnostic tasks appropriate to own competency level;
- work in a team (as per the physician's instructions) in eliminating acute life-threatening situations, performing patient classifications, treatments and assist in medical interventions;
- perform special emergency tasks of a specialist nurse;
- organise and arrange the transport of patients in critical state;
- prepare and use the medical, nursing and IT equipment used in emergency procedures and provide for their resupply;
- document the patient care process according to own competence level;
- participate in the training of nurses doing their field practice as well as in the research and development of emergency specialist care.
