- operate washing and dry cleaning machines;
- operate cleaning equipment for leather, fur, carpet, feather and strip curtains;
- finalise the shape and surface of textiles with steaming/ironing;
- operate a manual flat-iron;
- perform the final check of the cleaned textile and arrange for the repair of any defect.
