- get dressed and dress up the members of the operating team;
- disinfect surgery area;
- manage and use sterile tools;
- assign materials and tools necessary for the specific type and stage of the surgery;
- use instruments quickly and precisely during surgical interventions;
- participate in averting unexpected, hazardous situations;
- handle tools and instruments (laser, diathermy, surgery microscope and other electro-surgical equipment, endoscope, Rtg image enhancer) with due consideration to work safety;
- disinfect materials prepared for sterilisation, group tools and instruments to prepare them for sterilisation;
- ensure that the operating room is clean and tidy;
- keep records of documents and databases pertaining to surgeries as part of the specialised surgery assistant tasks.
