- use protective pieces of equipment (gloves, glasses, laboratory coats, masks, lead aprons) professionally;
- pay attention to the large-scale disinfection, cleaning and maintenance of endoscopes;
- properly use the endoscopic parts and components as well as clean and disinfect them;
- perform tasks related to emergency endoscopic treatment;
- document the medical activities and properly manage patients' medical records;
- ensure that test samples are stored appropriately and are sent to diagnostic laboratories.
