## 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

### A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

- apply his or her knowledge of the professional field in practice in the course of the development of the disease in order to provide care for people with dementia;
- recognise appearing symptoms indicating dementia;
- recognise whether in the current stage of the disease it is necessary to consult with respect to the problems of the client or whether it is necessary to send the client to a specialist;
- identify the stage of dementia;
- recognise BPSD symptoms and react in a way which ensures that symptoms are balanced by the application of the appropriate conduct;
- participate and cooperate in educational programmes for relatives and the environment;
- apply necessary interventions such as medical and physical treatments within his or her competence;
- create an inspiring daily schedule for the patient;
- recognise the burden on himself or herself;
- in addition to the provision of professional consultational background, as a member of the therapy team, handle behavioural deficits occurring to people with dementia, as well as recognise and treat changed states different from healthy functioning;
- recognise deficits in the daily activity of persons and adapting the process of caregiving and nursing to such deficits;
- cooperate within the team in the establishment of the nursing diagnosis and apply it in practice accordingly;
- cooperate with the family of the patient as a partner;
- intervene continuously and efficiently in order to recognise, prevent and treat prehospital symptoms, emergencies;
- recognise social challenges related to ageing and degradation;
- recognise problems related to caregiving and deficiencies in the reactions given to the needs of patients;
- during caregiving apply special methods for the care of persons with dementia, such as: 'assist me' model, person-oriented thinking;
- recognise signs of abuse;
- plan, organise and conduct group sessions, with the application of practices known by him and ensuring or allowing the employment of people with dementia, as well as cooperate in the elaboration of professional group sessions providing employment for people with dementia;
- plan the functional assessment of people with dementia;
- provide information for people with dementia and their relatives with respect to the protection of rights;
- psychologically support people with dementia and their relatives while letting life go;
- apply the special and effective means and models of communication in the relationships between the caregiver and the patient as well as the caregiver and the relatives.
