- perform hygienic hand disinfection;
- perform pre-surgery scrub disinfection;
- get dressed and dress up the members of the operating team;
- disinfect surgery area;
- manage and use sterile tools;
- assign materials and tools necessary for the specific type and stage of the surgery;
- use instruments quickly and precisely during surgical interventions;
- apply anatomical and physiological knowledge professionally;
- provide support/assist in ambulatory surgery;
- participate in the avertion of unexpected, dangerous situations;
- handle devices and instruments (laser, diathermy, operating microscope and other electro-surgical devices, endoscope, RTG image intensifier) while taking into account conditions for safe work;
- ensure and monitor the sampling of different surgical histological sections and secretions and their sending to examination in accordance with the protocol;
- disinfect materials to be sterilized, classify devices and instruments, prepare them for sterilization;
- ensure that the surgical room is clean and in order;
- organise smooth patient flow in the surgery, coordinate the activities of perioperative assistants and surgical assistants;
- keep documentation and records included in the tasks of a specialised assistant and related to surgery.
