- take over and transport the device/have it transported to the place of repair in return of an appropriately issued document;
- identify the error of the devices/equipment in accordance with the technical documentation (design, circuit diagram, manual) by analysing the identified and reported error with the use of appropriate devices, electronic and mechanic manual tools and machines;
- order materials and parts from catalogues or otherwise (commerce) for repair;
- repair and install the household appliances based on the documentation;
- cooperate with the representatives of similar professions, if necessary;
- run a trial and put into operation the repaired/installed device/equipment;
- hand over the working device/equipment which has met the requirements of safety examinations;
- issue necessary documents, invoices, and provide information on the use of the device and the work guarantee of the repair;
- comply with environmental, fire protection, electricity and other safety requirements during his or her activity.
