- correcting wrong behavioural patterns of dogs;
- appropriate communication and cooperation with trainers, the visually impaired clients signing checking in or being in the familiarisation phase with the dog or those who have already taken the examination or receiving follow-up care;
- comforting management of conflicts, if needed.
