- Decide about the possibility to perform hearing tests in possession of the knowledge related to ear diseases;
- plan and perform subjective and objective hearing tests;
- Perform clear voice threshold test, record and interpret its results;
- Depending on the results of the threshold test, plan further above-threshold tests and objective tests in consultation with an audiologist specialist and perform them;
- plan and perform subjective (traditional hearing tests, tuning fork tests, clear voice hearing threshold, speaking audiometry, recruitment and auditory fatigue tests, tinnitometry) and objective tests (tympanometria, stapedius reflex, otoacoustic emission, BERA, ASSR, MLR, CERA);
- perform subjective and objective hearing tests on children in accordance with their age;
- Carry out preventive tasks;
- recognise audiological emergency disorders, and perform patient referral accordingly;
- assess the physical and psychical state of the patient, the patient's needs, assess the factors influencing the selection of hearing aids and their fitting;
- give information on the possibilities of hearing rehabilitation, hearing aids, hearing systems, accessories;
- be aware of the indication of hearing aid surgery procedures, perform patient referral accordingly;
- taking into account the test results and the patient's needs, select the hearing aids and hearing systems in consultation with the audiology specialist, prepare a hearing rehabilitation plan;
- perform the programming of hearing aids, synchronisation of hearing systems;
- perform hearing and hearing rehabilitation care;
- By applying his knowledge of hearing rehabilitation, use hearing aids, accessories;
- Perform free sound field tests, life quality tests, assess the effectiveness of hearing rehabilitation;
- Interpret the content of the medical prescription, comply with medical instructions, perform compliant medical prescription management;
- know and apply commercial legislation;
- Perform commercial activities (handle money, issue invoices, stock, order, keep registers).
