- participate in the preparation and application of tools, materials used in perioperative treatment;
- assist in the reception and handover of patients in different professional fields;
- assist in the placement of patients in a supine position;
- assist in the preparation of non-invasive and invasive interventions;
- monitor, evaluate and document the condition of patients;
- recognise life-threatening conditions;
- cooperate in the prevention of life-threatening conditions;
- cooperate in the preparation of tools used for analgesia/amenities;
- provide assistance in the preparation of the documentation of patients who are transferred and/or admitted to leave;
- use the guidelines, requirements of the applied quality management system;
- participate in the psychological preparation of patients;
- prepare endoscopes and their accessories for intervention;
