3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

- Collect revenue due to the railway company in relation to ticket inspection activity in order to protect the property of the railway company;
- Monitor international tariffs and exchange rate changes in order to be able to provide up-to-date information;
- Perform ticketing activities for the purpose of collecting revenue due to the railway company;
- Issue certificates related to general damages and refund, take into account the observations and remarks of passengers and handle complaints;
- Report without delay any unusual event, fill out the required forms related to the incident and prepare a railway incident report at the end of the shift;
- Discharge duties related to fraudulent travel;
- Serve passengers by arranging for the lighting, heating and cooling of the delivered train carriages and by ensuring taking the necessary measures:
- Indicate issues of cleanliness as well as any technical deficiency in accordance with the local regulations so that measures can be taken as soon as possible;
- Arrange for changing the direction signboards and control the passenger information display system;
- Distinguish between different railway track signals used by the infrastructure manager, be familiar with their grouping and aware of their significance;
- Obey the signalling of different railway track signals and follow the instructions given by them;
- Enforce the rules to be followed during shunting and in traffic;
- Operate the interior technical equipment of passenger carriages and monitor its operation.
