3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES**A typical holder of the certificate is able to:**

- describe the properties and possibilities of use of the fibrous materials used in the textile industry;
- describe the properties and possibilities of use of non-woven products;
- describe the properties and possibilities of use of woven and knitted products;
- describe textiles of special quality criteria;
- describe leather and fur types;
- describe the washing, cleaning, dyeing, bleaching and colouring materials used in the textile industry;
- prepare raw fabrics, knitted (crocheted) fabrics, other textiles for dyeing and patterning;
- select the necessary mechanical tanning technologies and machines;
- operate dyeing machines;
- select the appropriate colour printing technology and the printing machine;
- wash out the textiles to remove excess colouring and auxiliary materials, then drain and dry them;
- fix the dimensions of the synthetic textile with heat treatment;
- manually add the dye, pre-treatment, post-treatment, washing and auxiliary materials required for the technology;
- operate the machines that automatically measure out the dye, pre-treatment, post-treatment, washing and auxiliary materials required for the technology;
- interpret the symbols indicated in the instructions for use and handling of the product to be cleaned, determine the raw material composition of the product in case of missing labels/information;
- operate washing and dry cleaning machines;
- recognise the origin of stains on the textile products and follow local stain removal procedures in the correct sequence;
- operate cleaning equipment for leather, fur, carpet, feather and strip curtains;
- finalise the shape and surface of textiles with steaming/ironing;
- use a hand iron professionally and in a way that helps preserve the quality of the fabric;
- perform the final check of the cleaned textile and arrange for the repair of any defect.
