- carry out an inspection on the spot based on documentation (plans, technical specifications);
- carry out related measurements, make recommendations on energy savings;
- carry out circuit installation works in intelligent buildings;
- make recommendations or give an expert opinion, in advance, on the placement of appliances;
- run a trial and put into operation the repaired/installed device/equipment;
- hand over the working device/equipment which has met the reuirements of safety examinations;
- issue the necessary documents, receipts (invoices) and provide information on the use of the machines/appliances;
- comply with environmental, fire protection, electricity and other safety requirements during his or her activity.
