3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

A typical holder of the certificate is able to:

- classify patients according to the urgency of their needs (triage), use different check-lists and scores to stratify risk;
- recognise acute, life-threatening conditions, avert them according to his/her competence and handle the case of patients in critical state;
 perform diagnostic tasks according to his/her competence;
- prepare, use and maintain medical, diagnostic and nursing IT equipment used in emergency care and ensure that they are in working order, are charged and replaced when needed, in accordance with local procedures and his/her qualification;
- prepare patients and the necessary pieces of equipment for diagnostic and therapeutic interventions and examinations;
- organise and arrange the transport of patients in critical state;
- continuously monitor and assess patients' condition;
- perform special emergency tasks of a specialist nurse;
- assess and meet the care needs of patients of different ages requiring emergency care;
- work in a team and contribute to its work by using his/her technical and non-technical skills, participate in the treatment of acute life-threatening conditions under the direction of a doctor;
- assist in the classification of patients into priority groups (triage) as well as in treatments and medical interventions;
- manage crisis situations and conflicts at a basic level;
- communicate with patients and their relatives and provide emotional support to them;
- provide health education at emergency care level;
- keep records of patient data, examination results, treatments, medication and the patient care process;
- carry out tasks related to quality assurance and work on improving medical care processes;
- participate in the training of nurses doing their field practice as well as in the research and development of emergency specialist care;
- participate in the training of nurses doing their field practice as well as in the research and development of emergency specialist care;
- assess and meet the care needs of patients of different ages requiring emergency care.
