3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES**A typical holder of the certificate is able to:**

- Devise the work procedures based on the plans received and weigh up the required technical tools and materials;
- Comprehend and implement the technical stage drawings;
- Handle the documentation related to the work;
- Apply the safety technical instructions related to the specific institution;
- Design and perform the lighting technical procedures of the performance;
- Based on the instructions of the director and the designer, supervise the lighting and other electrical tasks/work of the performance complying with the set deadlines;
- Ensure that the lighting accessories, materials and individual lighting devices of productions are prepared/produced by the set deadline;
- Make a scenario of the productions/performances being played and document these productions;
- Take care of the professional servicing of the performances;
- Define all the stage lighting tasks related to the performances and rehearsals of the theatre, manage and continuously oversee the performance of these tasks and ensure that the performances go smoothly and undisturbed;
- Provide technical opinion and advice on the electrical solution of tasks related to lighting and other issues involving the auditorium, the stage and other closely related facilities;
- Control the accident-free and serviceable state of devices and tools under his/her care and forming part of the lighting stock;
- In case of equipment failure, ensure its immediate repair, organise the servicing activity and the replacement of the equipment/devices;
- Keep a service book on the lighting tools, accessories and equipment/devices and keep a record of them in a documented form;
- Organise and continuously check the storage of lighting technical tools and materials and keep a record in a documented form of the utilisation of consumables;
- Make proposals regarding the scrapping and expansion of equipment and tools;
- Form a professional judgement on the safety condition related to electricity and define the danger situations;
- Make an objective judgement on the generated electric danger situation, in case of delayed remedy suspend the operation of the equipment until further action is taken and prohibit its use until the failure is solved;
- Take care of the time proportionate performance of tasks bestowed upon him/her in the minutes of work protection inspections;
- Ensure that the stage work area of lighting technicians is kept clean;
- Supervise the loading and unloading work related to transportation tasks;
- Control the compliance with fire and work protection regulations;
- Be responsible for the cost-efficient use of electricity and electrical accessories on the lighting work area and for the protection of the theatre's assets;
- Based on the instructions of the director and the designer, take an active part in the lighting procedure of the performances to be put on stage;
- Perform the stage fixing/fitting works required for meeting the stage scenic requirements of pieces to be put on stage;
- master the lighting set-up requirements and instructions to comply with for the performances;
- perform all the stage lighting tasks related to the performances and rehearsals of the theatre;
- operate, check and maintain scenic lighting equipment and systems;
- check whether the equipment they are in charge of is in safe, working order and ensure the smooth running of the performance;
- perform visual technology tasks.
