- Trim the hoof;
- Select or prepare a fitting shoe;
- Shape and adjust the shoe to the hoof;
- Perform finishing works on the shoe;
- Select the nail of the appropriate size and type;
- Nail the shoe to the hoof;
- Inspect and judge the horse's movement after shoeing;
- Make arrangements and consult with a veterinarian in case of any disorder;
- Prepare tools and devices for hoof care;
- Manoeuvre the cattle into hoof care position;
- Perform hoof care;
- Perform medical treatment and hoof protection treatment based on the instructions by the veterinarian.
