- perform on-duty and coordinating tasks with the organisations involved in the settlement's operation;
- based on legal authorisation, participate in imposing on-site public administration fines or reporting to the police on traffic rules violators and those displaying banned or anti-community behaviour;
- participate in initiating or conduction infringement or public administrative procedures; initiate seizure or confiscation of in cases specified by law or municipal decrees; or carry out inspection of clothing, packages and vehicles;
- participate in implementing social crime prevention tasks for the sake of public order and public safety;
- participate in the supervising the enforcement of legislations on public hygiene;
- participate in the operation of surveillance systems;
- take action in the event of any public danger;
- provide assistance and, in emergency, administer first aid to citizens requesting help;
- operate telecommunications equipment;
- participate in the protection of public, built-up and natural environments;
- apply law enforcement and self-protection equipment to avert resistance to legal action and any dangerous situation;
- participate in vehicle transportation off the site and in applying wheel clamps as specified by law.
