- identify most typical diseases of horses and also care for sick and injured animals based on the instructions received from the veterinarian;
- perform mare trials and participate in their insemination;
- identify the symptoms of nearing delivery, make preparations and provide assistance during delivery;
- carry out primary, before and after work care and treatment.
