- coordinate shopping for the kitchen and for catering with the economical use of own products;
- fill in contracts, agreements, invoices and other documents;
- prepare tender applications;
- comply with animal health, animal welfare and environmental protection regulations;
- introduce own farm and residential environment;
- set up and furnish a catering facility in a rural setting;
- care for the flowers and pets;
- prepare and process crops domestically;
- provide outdoor catering (on open fire);
- prepare food, prepare and serve home-style and diabetic as well as vegetarian meals;
- collect and use information related to husbandry, hospitality, and the improvement of village and agricultural tourism;
- organise regional programmes;
- introduce folk trades and traditions to others;
- perform procurement activities;
- communicate with competent authorities;
- establish and furnish accommodations;
- receive guests and provide for their accommodations;
- lay the table and serve food and drinks;
- provide for the safe storage of equipment, food, chemicals, etc.;
- operate household appliances and kitchen equipment;
- comply with health and safety and environmental protection rules;
- keep accurate records;
- keep records of stocks, revenues and expenditures;
- perform household duties (cooking simple meals, washing, cleaning, household care, and ensure order around the house);
- perform baby and child care, and patient care tasks;
- help in caring for children, the sick and the old, primarily in household duties;
- implement selective waste collection;
- clean and disinfect the social facilities and furniture of flats, accommodations, pensions, factories and farms;
- wash and repair textiles.
