- the art conservation technician Museum collection and warehouse manager handles artworks under the professional supervision and guidance of a museologist and/or a qualified conservator and in compliance with museum legislation;
- prepares, moves, and packs various types of artworks for exhibitions, research, restoration, loan, photography, and digitisation purposes, consciously applying art conservation standards;
- controls the condition and environment of artworks (climate conditions, hygiene) in the warehouse and on the exhibition site;
- reports to his/her supervisor in the case of conditions that deviate from the preventive conservation requirements;
- works in a dedicated and conscientious way to conserve artworks;
- takes part in the organization of museum storages;
- performs administrative tasks (preparing electronic and paper-based lists of objects, managing record-keeping software, data entry) accurately and attentively;
- works in a team, in cooperation with professional museum staff;
- applies the laws, orders, and legislation concerning the operation and registration of museums and the protection of cultural property, as well as the rules on work, fire and accident protection.

#### WRITTEN EXAMINATION EXERCISES

In the exam, the candidate must answer a set of centrally compiled questions. The first part of the series of a question consists of test questions, including both single and multiple answer tasks. The second part consists of essay questions. Subjects: - The place, task and role of the museum in the transfer of culture, the basic forms and most important rules of Hungarian museum activity. - Hungarian museum history, art collection and Hungarian museum legislation - The environment and management of different types of collections (archival, library, historical, technical, industrial history, ethnographic, fine arts, archeology, natural science objects) - Tools and methods for packing, storing, exhibiting and moving different types of artworks. Appropriate and inappropriate packaging materials in terms of the protection of works of art - Properties of organic and inorganic materials (leather, bone, wood, plastic, metal, ceramics, stone, textile, glass), as well as composite objects made from them, the causes of their damage and their appearance. Preventive protection of artworks - Environmental factors influencing works of art and various opportunities for their regulation. Protection against biologial pests. Handling of air conditiong and measurement devices - The registration and administrative activities taking place in the museum and their rules. Use of art registration software. Materials and tools for introducting inventory numbers and QR codes. Revision - Museum safety, the basics and rules of occupational, fire and accident protection - Photography of works of art, requirements of documentation photographs, taking photographs can be uploaded to the register.

#### PROJECT EXERCISES

Examination part a): Presentation of the final thesis of the museum collection and storage management. In the final thesis, the candidate gives an account of the museological, legal knowledge, institutional history and artwork preservation knowledge acquired during the training by presenting a freely chosen museum institution. The final thesis must contain the following chapters: Museum history. Presentation of a museum institution's collection and the work of the collection manager. Archives protection proposal regarding the work of the institution and the collection manager based on what was learned during the training. Professional discussion on the final thesis. Examination part b): Packaging of a chosen "work of art". The examinee packages the object designated by the committee for rental purposes in accordance with the regulations for the protection of works of art, by selecting the most appropriate of the available packaging materials. Finally, the movement of the object is recorded in the simulated movement diary.
