- Independently performs the duties of a fire protection and other competent authority officer, prepares reports of offences or criminal offences, initiates administrative sanctions, imposes on-the-spot fines;
- Carries out authority inspections on the basis of requirements for buildings, structures, industrial and service activities and the fire safety equipment used in them;
- When assisting in the fire investigation procedure, obtains data relevant to the effective conduct of the fire investigation, from natural or legal persons, carries out searches for such data or aggregates the data;
- Communicates within the organisation, with partner organisations, utility providers, local professionals, contributors and customers at the scene of an incident. Provides information on the procedures in relation to incidents and authority work;
- Participates in the defence management system and performs civil protection and industrial security tasks within that;
- Carries out the civil protection and industrial safety tasks of disaster protection;
- Prepares the classification of municipalities into disaster protection classes during a risk assessment process. Prepares a hazard mitigation plan. Assists in the establishment of civil protection organisations;
- Orders the use of appropriate personal protective equipment during fire-fighting and technical rescue operations, taking into account fire, occupational safety and accident protection rules, and has them maintained after the operations and during cyclical maintenance;
- Proposes and participates in the implementation of protection measures, in the event of an intervention, in the context of his or her civil protection tasks (individual and collective protection);
- Selects the appropriate fire-fighting equipment and gives instructions on how to use during the start of damage prevention. Gets involved in the periodic supervision of specialised fire-fighting equipment;
- Orders the alert, and goes to the scene of the incident, using data from decision support systems and orientation tools;
- Selects and operates the software used in the Disaster Protection Operations Management. After receiving the signal and filling in the incident report form, determines the first alert level of the incident applying the software used in the Disaster Protection Operations Management;
- Gets involved in the approval procedure for fixed fire protection installations on behalf of the authority, in particular by analysing the submitted design documentation, formulating his or her technical comments and drawing up the decision;
- Carries out training tasks in accordance with the annual training plan and contributes to the elaboration of these tasks;
- Performs the tasks of fire-fighting or rescue supervisors. Performs management tasks at more complex incidents. Provides incident reporting.
