- Applies special core concepts related to cleaning, healthcare and community-acquired infections;
- Apply procedures to prevent infections and hinder the spread of infections (cleaning and disinfecting surfaces and equipment);
- In relation to general, special and disinfectant cleaning, they are capable of selecting the appropriate materials and equipment required for cleaning and disinfecting, assessing the size of the area to be cleaned and the quality of the surfaces to be cleaned. Performs their work in accordance with requirements, standards and procedures by selecting the appropriate technology;
- Capable of identifying the colour codes assigned to the surfaces to be cleaned, selecting the tools, materials, chemicals and technologies required and applies them in a professional manner;
- Selects and uses acidic and alkaline neutral detergents in accordance with the instructions on the use, filling and dilution of cleaning products according to the health, safety and environmental protection regulations, taking into account the classification of the area to be cleaned, the contamination and nature of the surfaces;
- Capable of preparing the working solution to be used (water temperature, concentration level) in accordance with the relevant (Office of the Chief Medical Officer, National Public Health Centre) regulations. Recognises signs of the unsuitability of the working solution (e.g. discolouration, foaming, flaky precipitation). Capable of cleaning surfaces in sequence from clean to soiled and cleaning surfaces in figure 8 shapes. Ensures that no untouched surfaces remain on the cleaned surface. Keeps the surface wet for the required contact time.;
- Ventilates, collects waste, prepares surfaces prior to cleaning (surface treatment, degreasing, removal of major stains manually or by machine (e.g. vacuum cleaner). Performs cleaning operations (wiping, washing, soaking, spraying, brushing) using alkaline cleaning products, tensides, window cleaning kits, cleaning trolleys and equipment, brooms, surface treatment, vacuum cleaners, plastic brushes, wiping cloths, mops;
- Carries out a survey of the soiling of the surface to be cleaned on public transport vehicles, prepares the necessary colour-coded equipment, selects the cleaning and disinfecting agents appropriate to the impurities and the surface, carries out daily or disinfecting cleaning tasks;
- Carries out the wiping and cleaning of glass surfaces, disinfection of floors, using an impregnation cleaning trolley with the colour-coded wiping cloths specified for the surfaces, as required in healthcare institutions;
- During continuous disinfection, carries out disinfectant cleaning with the disinfectant specified to kill the pathogen at the necessary concentration in accordance with the colour codes. Applies appropriate lockout and tagout procedures. Performs initial daily disinfectant cleaning of the operating theatre, disinfectant cleaning between operations and daily closing disinfectant cleaning using an impregnation cleaning trolley and colour codes. Additionally performs periodic disinfection cleaning inside the lock;
- Applies lockout and tagout procedures, for both persons as well as equipment and materials. Washes the ceilings, walls, windows, fixtures and fittings, floors of rooms in accordance with the cleaning rules, using a cleanroom technology trolley, in accordance with the colour codes prescribed. Cleans and disinfects cleaning equipment after work, stores them in a closed place free of contamination;
- Uses required individual protective equipment;
- Capable of determining what work processes, procedures and sequencing are required for a given cleaning procedure at a particular cleaning site;
- Performs their activities in compliance with occupational safety, health, fire, accident and environmental protection regulations;
- Applies personal hygiene requirements throughout their work.
