3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

- assist in the rehabilitation of dogs with musculoskeletal and neurological disorders involving paralysis;
- carry out their work according to an independently prepared therapy treatment plan;
- establish the therapy treatment plan at all times following the veterinary diagnosis;
- understand the veterinary diagnosis of musculoskeletal diseases, relying on their knowledge acquired during the vocational training;
- identify the areas to be involved in the rehabilitation and plan the kinesic therapy treatment, relying on their anatomy knowledge;
- use simple unlicensed electrotherapy equipment, so-called transcutaneous electrical nerve stimulation (TENS) devices and therapeutic ultrasound equipment professionally, relying on their professional physiotherapy knowledge;
- use hydrotherapy if necessary;
- use their clinical knowledge to recognise situations—deterioration, increase in pain—that are beyond the competence of the dog physiotherapist and refer the dog to the vet;
- act at all times in accordance with the Animal Welfare Act and comply consistently with its provisions in the course of their work;
- inform the treating vet if they notice inadequate animal husbandry practices, taking into consideration the provisions of the Animal Welfare Act.
